**DEPUTY FIRE CHIEF**

**Description of Job:** Provision of community fire prevention and education services. Assists Fire Chief as necessary and acts as Chief in his absence including the role of emergency response commander on scene.

**Required Qualifications:** Minimum qualifications include high school graduation plus the completion of the required fire training courses as required by the Province of New Brunswick (NFPA Firefighter I & II), together with 5-7 years of progressively responsible experience. Local Assistant designation by the Fire Marshal's office is required (NFPA Fire Inspector I considered an asset; if not already obtained then the successful candidate must enroll and complete the course within a reasonable timeframe). Must be fluently bilingual.

Preference will be given to fully qualified candidates, however, those who can demonstrate ongoing preparations may be considered.
