WHY get a building permit?

A BUILDING PERMIT MUST be obtained before you start working on a new building, an addition, or any alterations to an existing building which is significant in nature.

Permits and subsequent inspections help ensure that all work meets National Building Code standards, as well as other regulations and standards. The process ensures that all applicable health, safety, and accessibility standards are met, protecting building owners, occupants, future owners, neighbours, and the community.



WHEN do I need a permit?

A BUILDING PERMIT IS required for all construction and renovation, but some exceptions may apply. Contact the Planning Department for more information.

A building permit is required before an electrical permit and a plumbing permit can be obtained from the NB Department of Public Safety, Technical Inspection Services and NB Department of Health.

A demolition permit is required before demolishing any building.

WHAT do I need to bring?

YOU NEED THE FOLLOWING documents before you apply for a permit:

- 1. Location of the project (civic address, street name)
- 2. Owner information (name, address, telephone)
- 3. Contractor information (name, address, telephone)
- 4. Type of work and Intended use
- 5. Description of work
- 6. Department of Health approbation for onsite septic system (if the site is un-serviced)
- 7. Other department's approval (if required)
- 8. Two sets of complete, scaled construction plans:

Your application **WILL NOT** be processed until you provide us with all the necessary documents.

HOW much do I need to pay?

PERMIT FEES AND ASSOCIATED deposits are due at the time of application, and may be paid by cash, debit card, credit card, or cheque payable to the City of Bathurst. Fee breakdown is as follows:

A: Building Permit (Construction, Renovation and Demolition Permit)

\$10 for every \$1,000 of the construction/renovation/demolition cost (minimum of \$25), and; Rebate of \$4 for every \$1,000 of the construction/renovation/demolition cost will be granted if the building permit is applied before the construction/renovation/demolition work begins.

C: Variances to the Zoning By-laws

\$100 for every \$1,000 of the project cost (minimum of \$100 and maximum of \$1,000)

WHO needs to apply?

THE OWNER IS RESPONSIBLE to apply for a permit at City Hall with all the required information. You should apply for the permit well in advance (at least 2-4 weeks) as the City needs to verify proper land use, health, safety, and other standards in your application.
